

Anglican Great Books

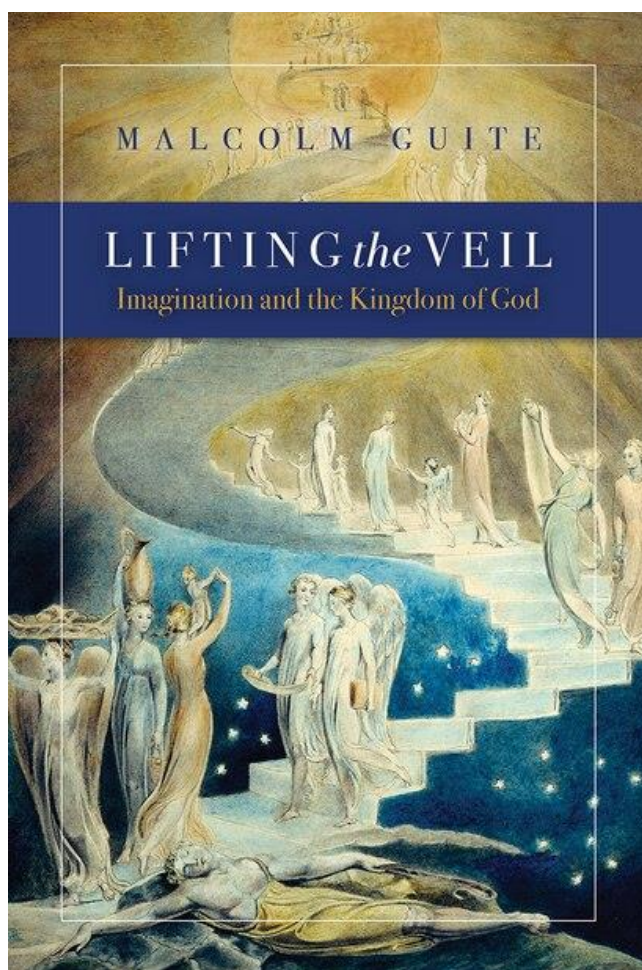
What: A Holy Trinity parish reading/discussion group on the most important books about Anglicanism, by Anglicans, or both.
